#### ECONOMIC PRICE ADJUSTMENT (EPA) MODIFICATIONS - \$950 and up

If your contract award was based on a Commercial Price List, you will need to escalate the prices via modification. You will need to include invoices to bolster the EPA request. We help you make sure you complete the paperwork, and we'll do the upload and post-award terms and conditions update as well.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE MODIFICATIONS - \$195 and up
